# MODESTY POLICY

*“PURITY REQUIRES MODESTY, AN INTEGRAL PART OF TEMPERANCE. MODESTY PROTECTS THE INTIMATE CENTER OF THE PERSON. IT MEANS REFUSING TO UNVEIL WHAT SHOULD REMAIN HIDDEN. IT IS ORDERED TO CHASTITY TO WHOSE SENSITIVITY IT BEARS WITNESS. IT GUIDES HOW ONE LOOKS AT OTHERS AND BEHAVES TOWARD THEM IN CONFORMITY WITH THE DIGNITY OF PERSONS AND THEIR SOLIDARITY” (CCC 2521).*

While we want the boys to be comfortable at camp, we also want them to be aware of the following things. We will be spending time in the chapel in prayer, possibly interacting with the public (lake day), and taking pictures for our promotional use. We do not want them to be distracting themselves or others throughout the week by their dress. If we have a concern with something being worn, we will ask the camper to change or we will find something appropriate for them to wear in our costume closet.

## **BOY’S CAMP GUIDELINES**

- Underwear must never be seen
- Pants and shorts must not be worn too low
- Shirts must be worn at all times
- Tattoos and body piercings must not be visible
- Ads or other references to drugs, tobacco, or alcohol products, inappropriate language or phrases are prohibited
- Swimwear: please wear a t-shirt with long swim trunks
