This includes psychological reports and counseling records. This is called the Publication of the Acts. Before viewing the evidence, each Party is required to sign an oath promising not to reveal anything learned, nor to act in retaliation. It is not required that either Party use their right to view the Acts. Furthermore, Respondents who have relinquished their right to participate in the process have also relinquished their right to the Publication of the Acts.
