ONGOING EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Application Process

Within the body of Certified Lay Ecclesial Ministers (CLEM), there will exist an Ongoing Education Advisory Committee (OEAC) that will work with the Director of Faith Formation to help plan various ongoing educational opportunities for CLEM.

Application process

- Those who are interested in being part of the OEAC should apply by filling out the online application.
- After they apply, they will be asked to do a short interview with the Director of Faith Formation (either in-person or through Zoom).
- After this process, members will be selected by the Office of Faith Formation.

Committee Roles

Director of Faith Formation

Oversees the Certified Lay Ecclesial Ministry program (initial and ongoing formation).

Deanery Reps (2/deanery)

Helps the Director of Faith Formation plan an annual retreat for CLEM members.
Helps plan an annual deanery day of reflection for their respective deanery.

Communication Coordinator

Works with the Director of Faith Formation to send out communication about upcoming events.
Creates flyers and graphics for various CLEM events.
Should have good proficiency with technology.

Other Info

- If there are no committee members from a given deanery, the Office of Faith Formation would not assume responsibility for a deanery event.
- Members of the committee would participate in quarterly meetings with the Director of Faith Formation to discuss and plan the above events. Meetings can be in-person or through Zoom.
- Members could also schedule any needed additional meetings with the Director of Faith Formation to plan for specific, upcoming events.
